The whole house or individual rooms are available for hire at reasonable cost.

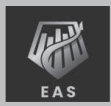
There is limited availability for hire on weekday evenings, but the building is available at some time on most weekdays, also Saturdays and Sundays during school holidays.

THE QUIET YES

“But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us” (2Corinthians 4:7)

As I sit down to write this article I can't quite believe it has been 2 years in the making. I began my training for Licensed Lay Ministry in September 2024 and, prior to that, took 18 months deciding if I heard God correctly and it should be the next step in my life as a Christian. But I'm getting ahead of myself because I probably need to explain what the term, often shortened to LLM, means.

The diocesan website states “A licensed lay minister is a lay person who, following a call from God, is trained and licensed by the Bishop to teach the faith, enable mission and lead in Church and society”

If that makes you want to run a mile, let me assure you, all of us in training felt exactly that. On the first evening of our initial residential course, we later confessed to each other, that: 3 of us phoned our other half and asked them to come and take us home, all 16 of us thought the others were a bit too wet-nosed and waggy-tailed to be true – and me? I felt far too average and unworthy to be there and had a quiet meltdown in my room.

But that's where God comes in. He took 16 ordinary, men and women and prompted us to respond to that next step in our lives that I mentioned earlier. We're all imperfect – the bible calls us (rather unflatteringly) “jars of clay”. We don't know all the answers to every curved ball life throws at us and our training was more heart knowledge than head knowledge but, here we are, at the end of our training and about to be licensed – 11.00 am on 26th September at Southwell Minster by Bishop Paul Williams (just to name drop!)

Will I set Bingham on fire? No, but my prayer is that God will. So, watch this space or better still come along to one of our events or services at Saint Mary & All Saints (see earlier pages for details).
